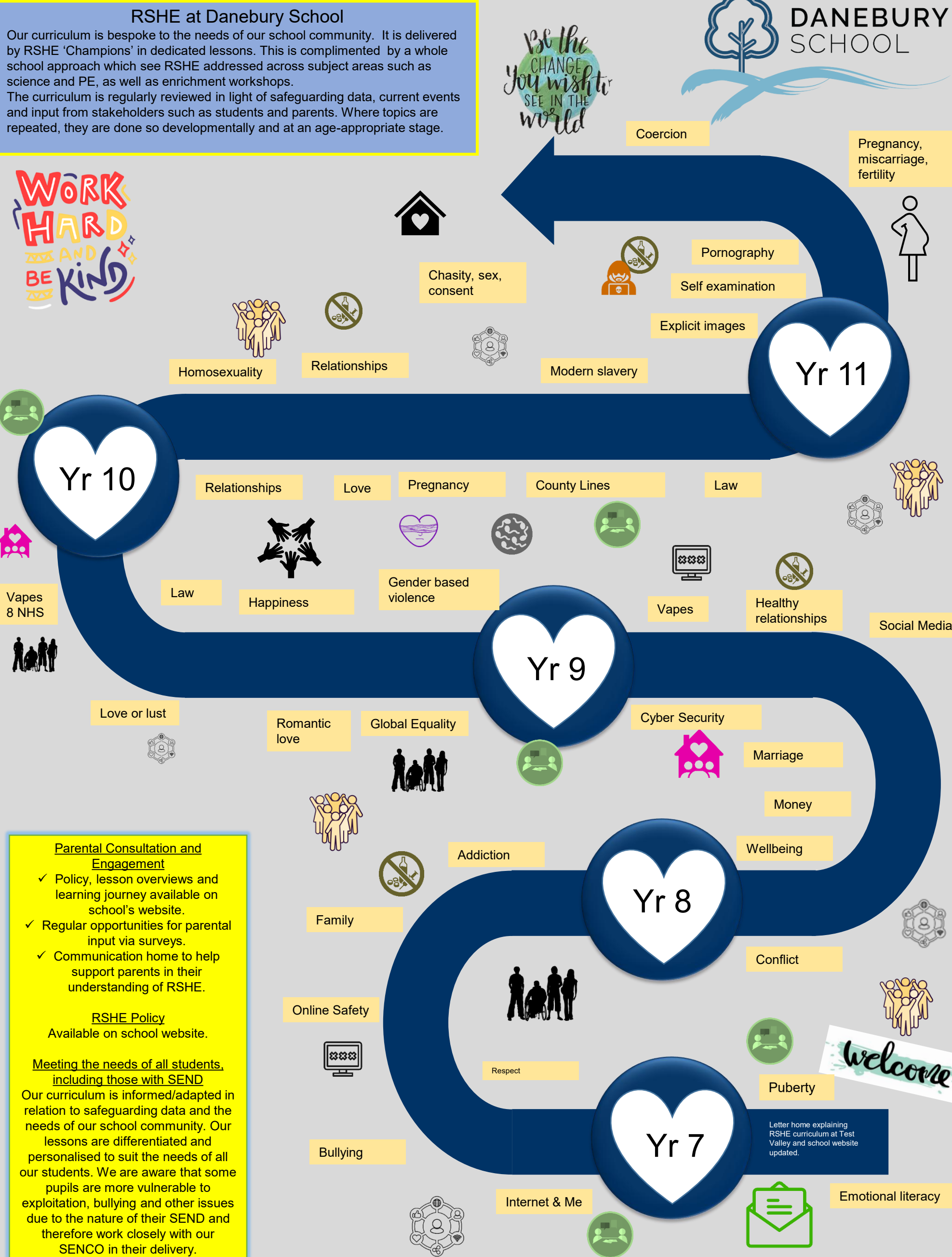


RSHE at Danebury School
